A LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

2019 Parish Survey Results

Dear Parishioners,

As part of St. Anthony of Padua's ongoing commitment to develop stewardship as a way of life, we conducted a comprehensive parish survey in February. The survey gave all our parishioners an opportunity to express their views regarding worship, parish life, religious education, outreach, and stewardship.

The parish office received 183 completed surveys, for a 35-percent response rate. I thank you for your honesty, as well as for the time and commitment you made to complete the survey and help our parish become better and spiritually stronger.

Just before I arrived in March 2016, the parish had participated in its first Parish Survey. When I received the results later on that summer, it was obvious to me where we needed to focus our initial efforts in adopting the Stewardship way of life in our parish. One priority was on the Stewardship pillar of Hospitality, towards which we needed to focus some energies on becoming a more welcoming parish to newcomers and visitors. Three years later, this report tells us that we have had significant progress in that area.

Another priority was to improve training and formation for our liturgical ministers, in particular our servers. The new survey indicates that people believe we are improving in that area, as well. Finally, there was concern about the vitality and viability

of St. Dominic School. Our current survey indicates that our parishioners understand and embrace our school as one of the most important and significant ministries of St. Anthony Parish, and now the questions and concerns about the school tend to focus more on making sure that our families and children are better-recognized as an integral part of our worshipping community.

In all of these past efforts, the current survey indicates progress. This is not to say that we are "perfect" in these areas, but that our parishioners recognize that we are not the same parish we were three years ago! As we look ahead to the next few years, the current survey tells us that there are areas in which we need to grow. As I explained in the previous paragraph, the first area of growth needs to be our school. Yes, we need to continue to strengthen the practical concerns about growing the student body, watching expenses, and providing the necessary resources to run an outstanding educational program, but most importantly, we need to shrink the "distance" we see between the school community and the church community. We are one parish and one community, who finds our "source and summit" in the worship that takes place on Sunday, and who invests in the future of the Catholic community through integral Catholic education that flows from that Sunday worship experience.


The second and third items come from comparison between the surveys in 2016 and 2019. Amazingly, almost all indicators of parish health and vitality showed improvement between the surveys, but two areas that showed little progress were in the Stewardship pillars of Christian Formation and Prayer. On page 2, we see that only 18 percent of our survey respondents have replied that they have been involved in Adult Faith Formation in the last three years. And of those that did participate, only about $\frac{2}{3}$ found it a "good experience." On page 6, we see that while $\frac{3}{4}$ of respondents pray before meals, that number is almost halved in homes with children. Further, only 23 percent of spouses make a habit of praying together. The results in 2019 are not much different than what we received in 2016. While all other areas of stewardship have been growing in our parish, these two areas have remained stagnant. Thus it will be a challenge for me and parish staff, as well as a challenge for all of our parishioners, to make an effort to be more intentional and diligent about making Adult Christian Formation and Prayer a shared priority.

While I am not sure yet how we will make progress in these areas, I suspect that we will need to think beyond the traditional

models of a program that meets on certain nights, like RCIA or *The Bible Timeline*, or simply announcing opportunities for confessions or devotions or other prayer activities. We must be a parish that develops resources and leaders to host and facilitate small groups of various affinities and interests. We must invite and encourage newcomers to become active in the devotional life of the Church. We must provide instruction and formation on how to pray in a way that enhances intimacy within families and among spouses, leading them to an even more fruitful encounter with our Sacramental Lord at Sunday Mass.

If we embrace this opportunity to be formed by these two pillars of stewardship, I am excited to consider what kind of parish we might be in three more years!
