A Message from Fr. Tom Donovan:



Every year on the Second Sunday of Lent, the Church reads an account of the **Transfiguration**. Jesus took Peter, James, and John up a mountain and presented a vision of his glory—a glory not otherwise seen by human eyes on this side of his passion and death. The disciples were amazed at this vision and desired to stay in the presence the sight—even 'pitching tents', so that they could remain in the presence of the mystery, rather than return the uncertainties of life at the foot of the mountain. The Lord chose not to allow this, leading the disciples down the mountain and back to 'real life', all the while teaching them that his passion and death as a necessary part of the mystery of his resurrection, which they had now received a taste of.


As we continue our Easter preparations, we are urged not to skip forward or take short cuts. We must fully embrace the Cross in order to appreciate the Glory of the Resurrection. Remaining disciplined in the practices of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving, and remaining disciplined in the habits of denying one's self and carrying the cross will, only in due time, result in the glorious changes in habit and attitude we are working forward to at Easter. If you haven't really started in your Lenten practices, now is the time to begin. If you have started and already been seriously tempted to give up, go, try again. The journey has only begun– there are still almost 5 weeks left to receive great gifts from God as part of our Lenten journey.




