



Trinity Sunday is the Octave Day of Pentecost, which traditionally is a week of celebration in honor of the Holy Spirit. With the revelation of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, we now can know the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, the three Persons of the singular Godhead. It is the age of the Holy Spirit that we live in now, not to the exclusion of Father and Son, for wherever the Spirit is, there also is the Father and the Son. It is through the Spirit that our groanings, our desire to encounter God, is brought to clarity of thought and speech and action (*cf* Romans 8: 26-27).

This weekend is also **Memorial Day week**end. Memorial Day originates from "Decoration Day" observances following the Civil War when the graves of those who died at war would be recognized and honored. Today we remember and honor those who died in defense of our nation. We also remember those who we call to mind in our hearts and memories, who have sacrificed for us, perhaps not going to war, but by giving us the love of a mother or father, sister or brother. Our cemeteries are sacred places of



faith, where the hope of the resurrection comes face to face with the very emotional, very human reality of death. We pray our observance of this day may inspire greater patriotism when considering the sacrifices of those who have given the full measure of devotion for their country, greater faith in light of the promises God gives to bring order and deliverance to our fallen world, and greater respect for all human life. **Mass at**
