The Feast of the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**, sometimes called by its Latin title, *Corpus Christi*, is yet another after-echo of the Easter Season we have just celebrated, transporting the mysteries of Holy Thursday out of the Triduum and placing them before us in Ordinary Time, when we consider the enduring presence of God in our everyday lives.

It is through the sacramental presence of our Lord in the Eucharist that he expresses his closeness with each of us, and our closeness with each other as his 'Mystical Body'. As St. Paul explains, "Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, are one body, for we all share in the one loaf" (1 Cor 10:17). The many grains, which are ground out represent the many different people, races, nations, theologies, traditions, times and seasons, politics, and other differences, which even if irconcilable in this world, none the less come together in radical unity through the Eucharist. This unity is not something that we create by our goodness, our social consciousness, or even our sense of justice... these virtues are too weak for what God has in mind. In the Eucharist we simply -are- one. One with neighbor, one with stranger, one with each other as the adopted children of God. If we call God our Father, we must recognize neighbor as brother and sister.

We invite the faithful to look at the host, once consecrated, and see the Real Presence of our Lord and God, Jesus Christ. Are you able to look deeply into that host and also see our neighbors in need? When you look deeply, can you see the Church which ministers to saints and sinners in all times and in all places? Can you see those who hunger and thirst for justice? Those who struggle with persecution in the name of the faith? Those martyrs who gave their life for the faith? Those who faithfully taught us and brought us to the sacraments? Those whose life is mystically bound in the life of Christ beyond this world? If we see Jesus, but fail to see how His Eucharist brings together all Christians into his Mystical Body, perhaps we are missing something of the grand mystery of this Holy Day?

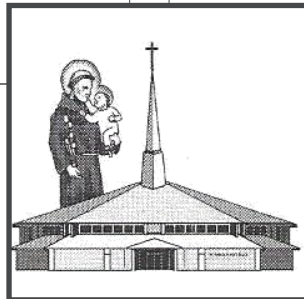
