A Message from Fr. Tom Donovan:

On behalf of the entire St. Anthony parish and St. Dominic school staff, I wish a Blessed Christmas to parishioners, families, and visitors! We are pleased that you join us for worship this day; may the sacred mysteries we celebrate this Christmas season renew in us the joy of God's redemptive love and inspire us to live more perfectly as witnesses to the Kingdom of God which is being revealed in our midst.

In this weekend's feast, we honor the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph—three persons bound in love as an earthly echo or afterimage of the Divine Trinity of Father, Son, and Spirit. With the challenges that face married persons and families in our day, I encourage us as a parish to dwell this season with the lessons of this "School of Nazareth" as Pope Paul VI so eloquently put it. While visiting Nazareth in 1964, he gave a talk that luminously praised the virtues of silence, family life, and dignified work, as exemplified by the Holy Family. In silence, our hearts are open and listening for the Word of God—hard to do in the busy-ness of contemporary family life, but nurtured by regular participation in Sunday Mass and family prayer. Family life inspires mutual respect and love among its members. Members of a family learn humility, interdependence, and respect for authority. Finally, the Holy Family was clearly a 'working class family', where the honest, skilled labor of St. Joseph not only provided a service to the local community and economy, but participated in the cycle of grace established by God after the Fall, where labor would yield a share of the graces of the land. The family would be thankful for the goods they earned, live within their means, and share the bounty of the land justly with all its members and with those in need. It is these virtues, among other things, that Mary observed and contemplated in her heart (Luke 2: 51) and which are set before us to day for our reflection.

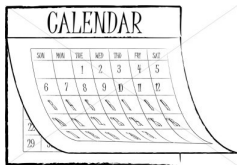

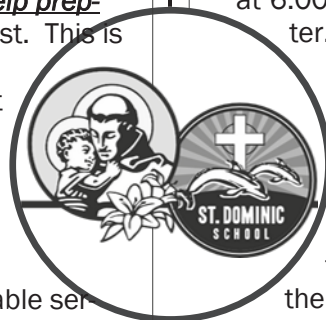
