A Message from Fr. Tom Donovan:



At the Last Supper, Jesus promised his apostles an Advocate, the Holy Spirit that will be sent in his name to 'teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." (Jn 14: 25) It is this Holy Spirit that animates the Church unto this day, giving her members access to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. The Holy Spirit provides for ministry and leadership in the life of the Church through the inspiration of religious vocations, the ordination of minis-

ters, and the deliberative processes of councils, conclaves, and synods. The Holy Spirit breathes life into Sacred Scripture, thus we call Scripture the 'inspired' Word of God.

When the Holy Spirit is near, we observe the Fruits of the Spirit in our midst: charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, perseverance (long-suffering), gentleness, faith, modesty, self-control (continence), and chastity. We observe the Gifts of the Holy Spirit as infused virtues in those living in sanctifying grace: wisdom, knowledge, understanding, fortitude, piety, fear of the Lord, counsel.

As we wrap up our 50-day celebration of Easter we recognize that we continue to live in the era of the Holy Spirit. Would it have been easier if Jesus simply remained among us in a way that we could go and see him and receive his counsel 'in person'? Perhaps. But the presence of the Spirit is nothing less the presence of God leading and guiding his Church and its members today. The Spirit inspires faith and growth in virtue by being immediately present to each person discerning God's presence in signs, wonders, and prayer, responding to the Spirit in the reality of their daily lives.

Memorial Day Mass will be held on Monday, May 26 at 9:00 am at Calvary Cemetery in Quincy. Note that there has been a change in the rain location, which will be at St.



Francis Church at 9:30 am, if necessary. There will be no morning Mass at St. Anthony. Historically, Memorial Day recalls those who have given their lives in service to our country through military service. We remember these sacrifices and pray that they may not go in vain, but inspire us who remain to strive to be a more virtuous nation and beacon of peace in our dangerous world. In addition to those who have died in service to our country, we also use this day to remember all who have gone before us into eternal life, praying that God's merciful light may shine on them, and that they may rest in peace.

Congratulations to Fr. Charles Delano and Fr. Ryan Kehoe, ordained priests for the Diocese of Springfield-in-Illinois on May 24 by Bishop Paprocki at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception.


